Wal-Roc USBCA Youth Association **Annual Championship Tournament Rules**

1. The tournament is open to all certified members of Wal-Roc USBCA Youth Association, unless under suspension or in violation of eligibility rules.
2. The USBCA Youth Association sanctions the tournament and their rules will govern this tournament.
3. **Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by tournament management. Bowlers will not be allowed to use any electronic devices (cell phones, IPODS, etc) or hats while bowling. Scores will not count for that game.**
4. Members may participate in the team and doubles event as often as they would like as long as they change 2 members for the team event and one member for the doubles event, but only once in singles. Make up teams are permitted. However, no more than two bowlers on the same team can place more than once in the prize list for position standings. Wal-Roc Youth will sponsor the bowler's singles events when they bowl doubles.
5. Bowlers from different age divisions may bowl together, Teams or Doubles may be boys, girls, or mixed (boys and girls).
6. Walk-ins will be allowed up to the beginning of the last shift of the tournament, providing there are lanes available. **Call for availability!**
7. Handicap will be 90% difference between individual average and scratch of 220 for each event:
8. Entering average options:
 - a. The highest previous seasons average (minimum 21 games)
 - b. Average one-week prior to the date of bowling. (Minimum 6 games) with average verification to follow within one week. (Standing sheet for that week must be sent Tournament Director for verification.)
9. No blind scores allowed. Substitutes will be permitted when replacement is necessary.
10. Falsification of an entry will result in automatic disqualification, with no return of entry fees.
11. **Coaches and/or bowlers must check in 30 minutes before scheduled starting time. A bowler arriving late will receive a 0 for the frames missed.**
12. Dates and times will be assigned on first come first serve basis. If there is a no show there will not be a refund.
13. Awards will be given on a 1 out of 5 entry based on entries, or a major portion thereof, in each division. Individual awards will be given to all members of winning teams. Duplicate awards will be given in the case of a tie. Tie for first will result in Co-champions declared.
14. There will be no flash photography allowed during competition.
